Harris St John's Wood Uniform Code

Students in years 7 to 11 at Harris Academy St John's Wood will wear a school uniform and the Sixth Form will wear smart business dress.

Main Uniform for years 7 to 11

Students must wear the full uniform every day, it must be neat and tidy to comply with the uniform code. Our uniform is predominantly dark blue with a sky blue trim and black with and a tartan skirt for airls.



In addition to this

Shirt

Shirts must be white, and not a blouse as a clip on tie will be worn. Any shirt without a top button is not compliant with the code. Top buttons must be done up and shirts tucked in at all times.



Trousers

Trousers must be black.

Girls may wear trousers as an alternative to the blue tartan skirt. They must be a bootcut/regular fit style and not tight fitting elasticised trousers or leggings. In order to avoid variation we ask that the bottom of the trousers are loose and touch the shoe.

Girls may also wear a long skirt for religious reasons, but it must be plain black. If tights are worn they must be plain black. High socks are not permitted, they must be plain, black ankle socks.

Boys' trousers must be business style and not casual chino style

Shoes

Shoes must be black leather, they must be plain black and cannot be trainers or look like trainers. They should be a shoe that can be polished and suitable to wear at a job interview. Boots of any kind including ankle books are not permitted.

Shoes must be leather and completely black , they cannot look like a trainer. Laces must also be black. Boots are not permitted.

School shoes can be purchased at a wide range of shops, if you are unsure please contact the school to ask.

Jewellery/make up

- No jewellery or make up is to be worn at all.
- Watches are not considered to be jewellery, they are permitted and encouraged.

Religious Clothing

- Hijabs must be navy blue or black and without embellishments

Outdoor Coats

- All outdoor coats must be sensible.
- They may be worn outside, but not inside the school. The same applies to scarves and hats.

PE kit

All students must wear school PE kit in PE lessons and when representing the school.



The school polo shirt is compulsory as are plain navy shorts. Tracksuit trousers are optional and must also be plain navy. The school tracksuit jacket is optional, no other jacket is permitted.

Girls may wear leggings as an alternative but they must be navy.
