Uniform policy 2023/2024

Hairstyles

Pupils are expected to come to school looking clean and smart each day. Fashion wear and styles are not part of our school uniform. Hair dye, gel and colour in hair are not permitted. Longer hair should be tied back.

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions to this rule are that girls may wear small earring studs in pierced ears. We ask the girls to remove these objects during PE and games to prevent them from causing injury. Watches are permitted in the Junior classes, worn at the pupil's own risk. Smartwatches are not permitted.

Shoes

The school wants all children to grow into healthy adults. We believe that it is dangerous for children to wear shoes that have platform soles so we do not allow children to wear such shoes in our school. Neither do we allow children to wear trainers to school; this footwear is appropriate for sport or playtime, but is not in keeping with the smart appearance of a school uniform. We ask that all children wear shoes as stated and shown in the uniform list.

Plain black or navy trainers are allowed as part of the outdoor PE uniform only. Children will not be allowed to wear trainers during the school day.

Outer Wear

A school coat **must** be purchased.

- Navy blue tracksuit bottoms
- Navy blue sweatshirt with school crest
- Blue polo shirt
- Wellington boots
- Grey socks for boys / white socks for girls

Reception to Year 6 school uniform for girls

- Grey skirt
- White blouse
- School tie elasticated for KS1 and traditional tie for KS2.
- Grey cardigan with school crest
- Grey socks or grey tights

- Appropriate black footwear
- School coat
- School book bag or school rucksack bag.
- Wellington boots

Summer uniform

(N.B. the summer uniforms can be worn from the start of Summer Term until October half-term only)

• Blue and white checked dresses to be worn with white socks

Reception to Year 6 school uniform for boys

- Grey trousers
- White shirt
- School tie elasticated for KS1 and traditional tie for KS2.
- Grey pullover with school crest
- Grey socks
- Appropriate black footwear
- School coat
- School book bag or school rucksack bag.
- Wellington boots

Summer uniform

(N.B. the summer uniforms can be worn from the start of Summer Term until October half-term only)

- Grey shorts
- Blue polo shirt with school crest.

P.E. Kits

- Appropriate sports trainers
- Navy blue P.E. shorts
- House t-shirt with school crest
- Navy blue tracksuit bottoms
- Navy blue sweatshirt with school crest
- School P.E. bag

Please note:

- Scarves and gloves must be grey or navy blue.
- Both Winter and Summer hats must be navy or blue with the school crest.
- All hair wear must be school colours. Hair accessories should not be ostentatious.
- All items must be clearly labelled with your child's name.
